Guide to the Nokendai Community Center

Operation days and time:

Weekdays and Saturday	9:00 am to 9:00 pm
Sunday and holidays	9:00 am to 5:00 pm

• Elementary school students can use the Nokendai Community Center until 5:00 pm and junior high school students until 6:00 pm unless they are accompanied by their guardians. As long as they are accompanied by their guardians, they can continue to use its facilities.

Closed days:

- First Monday every month excluding January (or the following Tuesday when the first Monday falls on a holiday)
- Year-end and New Year holidays from Dec. 28 to Jan. 4

Limitation to the use of the Nokendai Community Center:

The Nokendai Community Center cannot be used under conditions described below:

- When used only for the purpose of profit making
- When used against the objectives of the Nokendai Community Center
- When used against the management of the Nokendai Community Center

How to use the Nokendai Community Center:

Individual use (free of charge)

1. For the use of the Group Room, take necessary procedures at the reception desk.
2. Use of the Gymnastic Room
 - Ping-pong rackets and basketballs can be lent.
 - Badminton rackets, ping-pong balls and badminton shuttles can be lent. Please ask at the reception desk.
 - Individuals are asked to play badminton or ping-pong in turns every 30 minutes.

Group use (for a fee for high school students or older)

How to make reservations (for groups):

1. To make reservations, you need to register your group at the reception of the Nokendai Community Center in advance. Your registration number to be issued when you register your group can be used in common at the Nokendai Community Center, Kanazawa Community Center, Kamariya Community Center, and Namiki Community House.
2. Making reservations by lot:
 - To make reservations on the website, please log into the screen for making reservations for applicable facilities at the Nokendai Community Center, Kanazawa Community Center, Kamariya Community Center, or Namiki Community House.
 - In addition to making application through internet, an applicant group can make a reservation by phone or by visiting the Nokendai Community Center between 9:30 am and 8:30 pm from Monday to Saturday, or between 9:30 am and 4:30 pm on Sunday and holidays.
 - From the first day to the tenth day of each month, you can make reservations by lot (in increments of three hours, up to a maximum of 12 hours per Community Center/House) for the period of one month for the month after next.You can cancel your reservations or make new reservations as many as you like during the period.
 - A lottery is held automatically on the 12th of each month, and the result is sent by e-mail. If your group has not registered its e-mail address, please contact the Nokendai Community Center.
3. Making reservations:
 - When rooms and facilities are available, you can make reservations on or after 16th of each month between 9:30 am and 8:30 pm (4:30 pm on Sunday and holidays) on a first-come-first-served basis. In addition, on the 15th of each month, you can make reservations through internet after 12:00 pm, by phone after 2:00 pm, or in person after 4:00 pm at the Nokendai Community Center.
4. To change the date and time of using rooms or facilities, and types of rooms or facilities, you need to cancel your current reservation before making new reservation.
5. Making reservations six or less days prior to use:
 - You can make reservations in person or by phone (from 9:30 am) for the use of rooms or facilities for more than four sessions per month.
6. On the day you rent rooms or facilities, you can extend the reserved period by one hour before and/or after the period respectively if no other reservation has been made for the rooms or facilities.

Crafts Room	16 For group use	Group activities such as craftwork class, flower arrangement class, cloisonne ware class, karaoke, etc.
Japanese Room	24 For group use	Tea ceremony, Kimono-wearing classes, group activities, etc.

Reminders when using the Nokendai Community Center

- After use, please vacuum the floor, and wipe the table top with a damp cloth.
- In principle, tables and chairs should be put back as illustrated.
- Please clean up after use within the business hour and ask the staff for confirmation.
- Please take your own rubbish with you.
- Smoking is prohibited all day long on the premises.
- Alcoholic drinking is prohibited in the facilities, and the facilities cannot be used after drinking alcoholic beverages.
- Eating and drinking are allowed except in the Gymnastic Room, Reading Area and Playroom.
- Please refrain from using electrical outlets in the Nokendai Community Center without permission.
- Please refrain from bringing your pets with you.
